France 2016

This Touraine Sauvignon Blanc offers great precision and clean aromatics. Very crisp and refreshing on the palate, it leaves a pleasant, mouth-watering finish with lovely flavours of pear and green apple. **£27.00**

22 Pinot Grigio, Alpha Zeta, Verona, Italy
2017

Clean & fresh. Juicy pear character. **£27.00**

134 Paccamora, Inzolia, Sicily 2017

The nose is fresh and vibrant with citrus notes and hints of peach & apricot The palate is supple with fresh acidity and a long, crisp finish. **£24.75**

24 Chateau La Bastide, Corbières 2016

Bright pale yellow colour. Peach, pineapple, verbena aromas. White fleshed-fruits & honey on the palate. Long aromatic finish. **£27.50**

80 Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine Font Mars, 2017

The palate is full but extremely well balanced, with fresh Picpoul acidity and pure fruit flavours. **£28.50**

57 Loimer Gruner Veltliner, Austria 2017

Dry with spicy, peppery & exotic perfumes of grapefruit & pineapple. Medium bodied with good levels of acidity & minerality. **£36.50**

England 2016**

From just around the corner, this is an unusual blend of Chardonnay, Pinot Gris and Ortega grapes. Medium bodied, perfect with lightly spiced food. **£27.50**

South West Australia 2017**

Delicate stone fruit aromas combine with flavours of grapefruit and lemon meringue for a subtle richness with a hint of minerality. **£37.50**

43 Pinot Gris, Bruno Sorge, Alsace, 2015

Rich, spicy & highly aromatic. Off dry hints of grapefruit. Honeyed & elegant. **£37.50**

**85 Pouilly Fume, Domaine Thibault, Andre
Dezat 2017**

Gold medal Paris, Low yields & great care in the vineyard and cellar make this Pouilly Fume one of the best. **£39.00**

**19 Sancerre, Domaine Pierre et Alain Dezat
2016**

Classic Sauvignon from an estate that has been in the top echelons of Sancerre production for the past 50 years. **£39.00**

**15 Muscadet, Les Hauts Pemions, France
2017**

Smoky nose, with a touch of toasted almond, gives rise to a substantial, polished palate with top notes of dried peach and apricot. **£27.50**

**100 Sauvignon Blanc, Shaw & Smith,
Australia 2017**

It's really well balanced in the mouth, the succulent but saline citrus fruit backed up by richer hints of stone fruit and tangerine, alongside a layer of wafting herbs. Very elegant. **£42.00**

Elegant & rich. One of Australia's best Semillons, highly recommended. **£42.00**

Intense colour and pleasant bouquet. In the mouth it is soft, expressive and elegant, combining a fruity character with perfectly balanced oak. **£28.00**

240 Vina Berceo, Rioja, Spain 2014

Perfect balance between the vanilla and spices from the oak and plummy, red berry fruit aromas. Smooth, well rounded, good backbone and a long finish. Perfect with all kinds of meats and roasts. **£28.50**

Alsace born Michel Dietrich spent 6 years in Australia perfecting his skills to produce an excellent Merlot, Cabernet blend. Six months oak aged. **£30.00**

The superstar of Rasteau, according to wine guru, Robert Parker. A great full bodied blend of Grenache, Syrah & Mourvedre. **£32.50**
